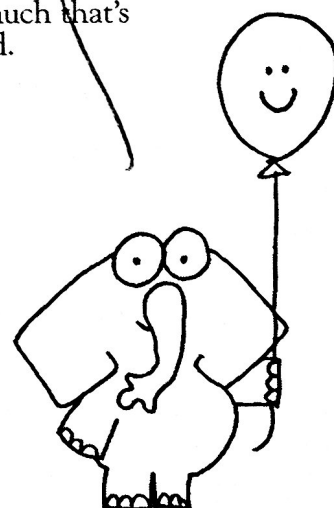
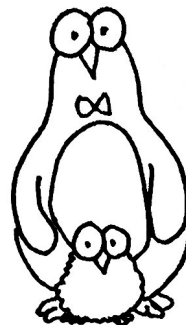
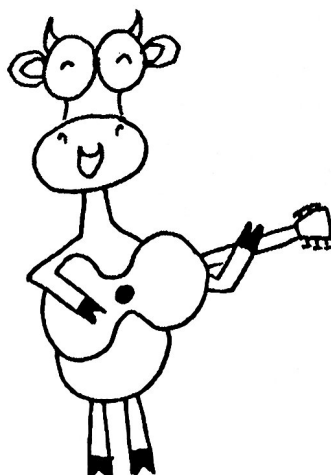
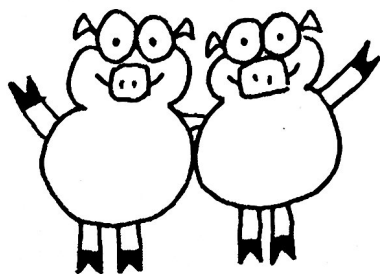


Sometimes the bad things occupy our minds

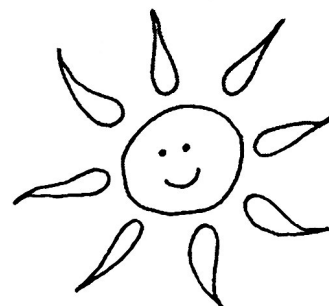
