## PROGRAM DETAILS & ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

Student-to-staff ratio is 20 students to one staff member.

ASES programs are funded by the State of California After School Education and Safety Program, also known as Proposition 49.

It is the intent of the California Legislature that elementary school pupils participate in the full day of the after school program every day of the academic year.

Programs are offered immediately after the regular school day and runs through 6:30 p.m. for elementary school and 6:00 p.m. for middle school.
